For all those ships and crew affected by piracy on the seas especially the tanker the 'St James Park' We pray for the cessation of such acts and the safe return of the crew and passengers.

(Pause) Father of light: R./ shine in the darkness.

For those serving in the armed forces especially those from HMS Eaglet. May they and their families be kept safe throughout this Holy Season and return home soon from their missions of peace and justice. (Pause) Father of light: **R./ shine in the darkness.**

For those who have died and for all those known to us who have died during the year 2009 - may the light of heaven may be theirs.

As we open our hearts to receive Jesus, we remember Mary's receptive love, and make our prayer with her as we pray **Hail Mary**
